



Making Freedom Fest a Reality

"WE USUALLY WORK with under-resourced students — but these are the most extremely under-resourced students we've ever worked with," said Will Savell, the sounds of his kids laughing in the background.

Will, President of The Grace Institute was updating us on Grace Institute's unique, five-month-long facilitators' training — affectionately known as "Freedom Fest 2022" — while briefly in the United States with his family before returning to Uganda. He went on to explain that during the Covid-19 pandemic, the number of students exploded in East Africa, and the leaders of Grace found themselves with a dilemma: Hundreds of students wanted to learn the Bible and theology, but no infrastructure was in place to begin training them.

The Grace Institute works primarily with rural Pentecostal students, most of whom don't even have a Bible. Faced with these conditions, Will and his team dreamed up a new kind of training for potential facilitators. They would bring around 100 students, hand-picked for their track record of starting groups, to Grace's facilities for an extended period of time. During their absence, their families would be supported with a salary from The Grace Institute.

The problem was, no facilities existed, and Grace didn't have the money necessary to provide for the families. So, Patrick Kibirige, Director of African Initiatives, began plans to build facilities to accommodate housing and teaching for such a large number of students. Meanwhile, Will and his team began raising funds for the project, planning the courses, and lining up professors to come to Uganda to teach.

One of their main goals was to develop a core group with a solid understanding of Scripture through the lens of God's kingdom and covenants. Over the course of five months, the students would go through five Thirdmill courses: Kingdom, Covenants and Canon of the Old Testament, The Primeval History, The Gospels, The Book of Acts, and The Book of Revelation. The hope was that this core group would then have a solid foundation for future study and be able to return to their communities to train others.

Four months ago, Freedom Fest 2022 began.

"One of my dreams has always been to provide these under-resourced pastors with the very best," shared Will, and Thirdmill resources fit that bill. Additionally, Dr. Greg Perry, Thirdmill's VP of Strategic Projects and President of Thirdmill Seminary, was able to teach part of the program in Uganda. "These students, who've never received anything, were able to listen to a true scholar and representative of Thirdmill — it was an amazing experience for them."

"Going into month five, it's exciting to see the growth of these students. We started with 102 and still have 99. All





blown away with what they're learning."

The retention rate has been one of the best surprises. Will designed a rigorous course of study, fully expecting 60% or more of the students to drop out within the first month. But they lost only three, and all for legitimate reasons. Will told us

that this is the first time these students have been exposed to an education of this level, and it's been emotionally draining and really difficult. Knowing that their families have been taken care of has helped them to persevere, but the students have faced all kinds of challenges while at the training.

Difficulties have arisen with their families or farms. Tribalism has been an issue among them. Daily schedules for eating and sleeping have been difficult to adjust to. The rainy season In addition, the professors and facilitators have had many challenges as well. The Grace Institute pulled many resources from other initiatives to make this project a reality. Will and Josh Warren, Grace's Director of Curriculum, have each spent more than 100 days in Uganda away from their families. Patrick has taken on many responsibilities beyond his regular job as founder and director of Good Shepherd Foundation. And many other guest professors and supporters have sacrificed time and money for these five months to happen.


"It's definitely worth it," said Will.
